OPTIMA ULTIMATE STREET CAR SCORING SYSTEM



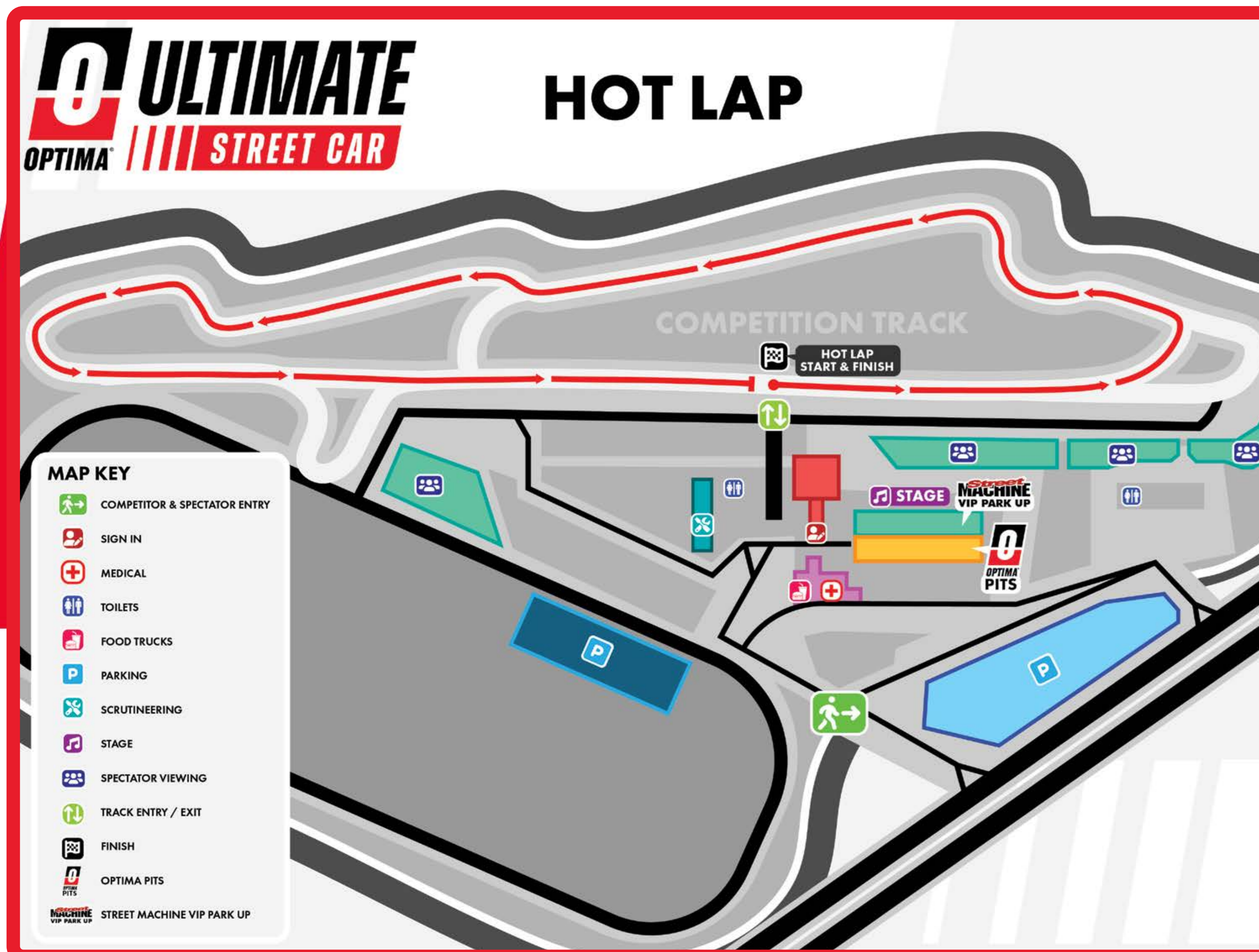
Each segment of the event will be timed to 0.00.00. A 100 point scoring system will award points based on the best time in each segment plus “Design and Engineering”. The “Design and Engineering” element will be judged on the construction and modifications that enhance the performance, functionality, and appearance of a vehicle, while maintaining or enhancing the “daily driver” features and accessories.

THE ENTRANT WITH THE MOST COMBINED POINTS OVERALL WILL BE THE OPTIMA ULTIMATE STREET CAR WINNER. WINNING A RETURN TRIP TO SEMA SHOW 2024 — AND NOT TO MENTION BRAGGING RIGHTS FOR BEING AUSTRALIA’S ULTIMATE STREET CAR.

There will also be trophies awarded for each “class winner”. This will be based off the most points overall in that class. To be an eligible winner you must have competed in all four events.



EVENTS - HOT LAP

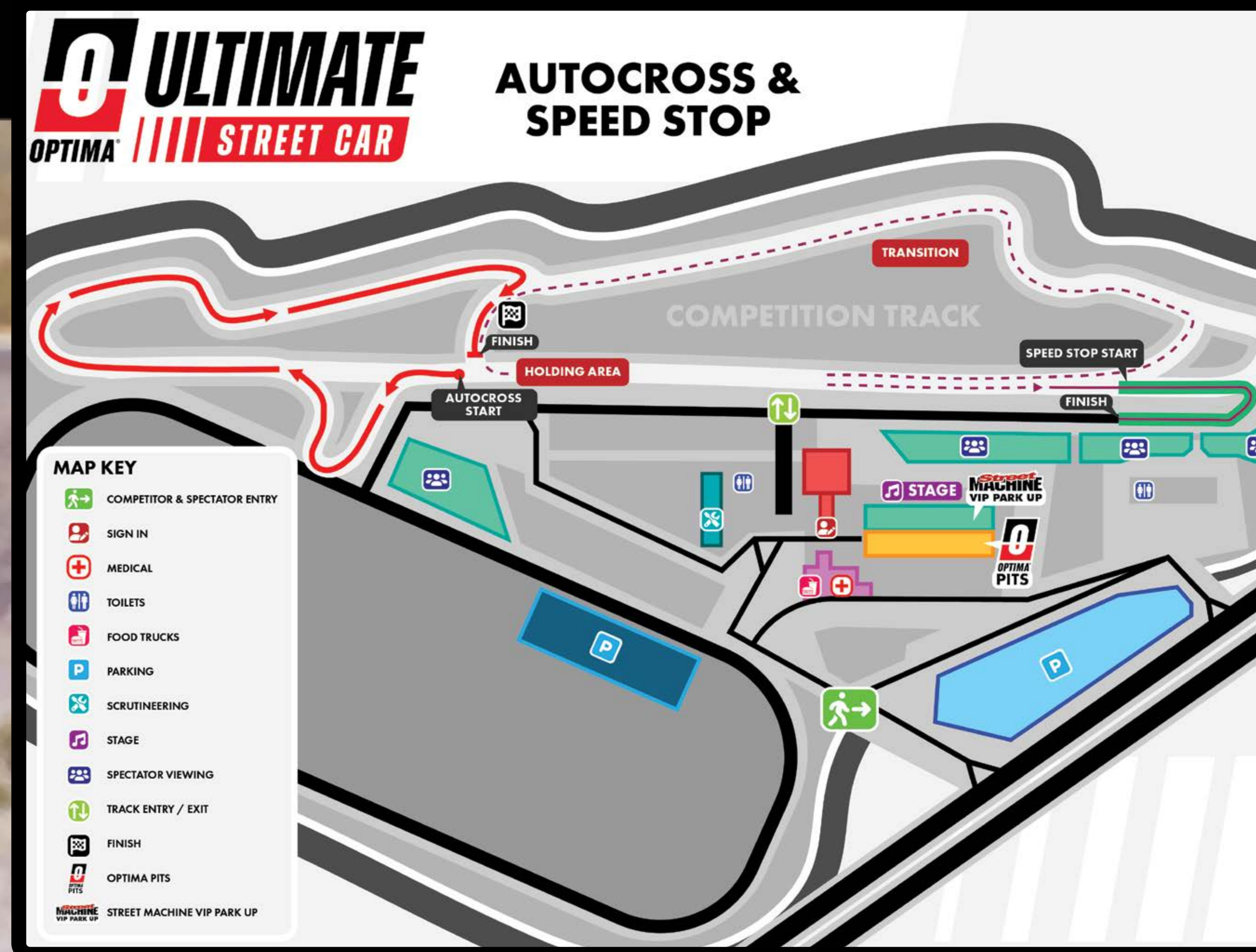


The Hot Lap event will be completed with three run groups (novice, intermediate, expert) running multiple sessions on Calder Park Raceway. Please make sure you check your group requirements [HERE](#).

Competing in a convertible or open top vehicle? Arm restraints are required during the hot lap event!

EVENTS - SPEED STOP

The speed stop comprises a short sprint through the drag-strip burnout box into a tight 180 onto the staging lanes, where a series of bollards must be navigated as quickly as possible before screeching to a halt in the brake box. A DNF will be imposed for knocking a bollard over or out of its outlined box. If a bollard remains standing and is touching the outlined box it is not a penalty.



EVENTS – DRAG RACE

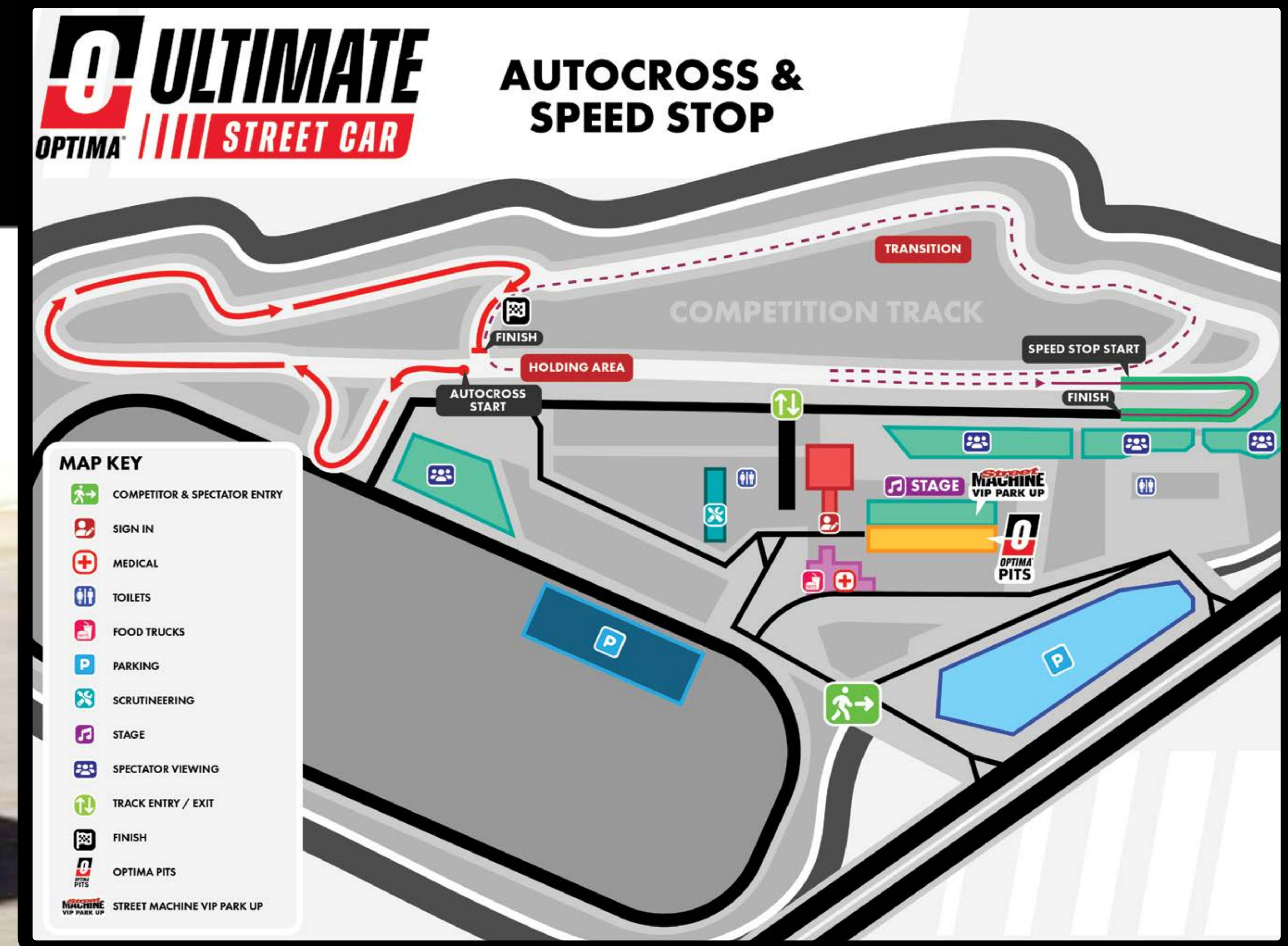


- Quarter-mile drag race down the legendary Calder Park Dragway!
- All entrants must complete at least one pass on the drag strip, the single fastest time to be given to officials
- Convertibles or open top vehicles must have roll over protection and arm restraints fitted

EVENTS - AUTO TEST



The auto test is a sprint down a short section of the main track, with a couple of tight turns and straights, plus a hairpin that catches pretty much everyone out! A two second penalty will apply for knocking a bollard over or out of its outlined box, if a bollard remains standing and is touching the outlined box it is not a penalty. Crossing or contact with any cones / bollards after the finish line is considered a violation and will result in a DNF.



LICENSING / SANCTIONING



- This event is sanctioned by the Australian Auto-Sports Alliance (AASA), and will be conducted under the AASA Lapdash Sprint Supplementary Regulations.
- At a minimum, entrants are required to hold an AASA day license at the event, or alternatively, any other AASA competition license.
- AASA Day Licenses are available at the event.

SAFETY, TYRES AND FUEL

TYRES

Entrants must use approved street tyres. Street tyres are defined as any treaded, non-competition tyre with a 180-tread wear rating or higher. Entrants must use a single set of tyres for the entire event, tyre changing is prohibited, and tyres will be marked during scrutineering.

FUEL

Drivers can bring maximum 40L in jerrycans and re-fuel in the pits, or there is a petrol station close by, BP.

Helmet use is required at all times during competition and must be an approved automotive helmet. Rules and Regs can be found [HERE](#).



SCRUTINEERING



- All entrant cars must go through scrutineering, located at the Calder Park Raceway Pit area.

- Don't forget to pick up your goodies bag, with your official event merchandise hat and shirt.
